Everyone needs to bring a copy of their health papers with each pig per exhibitor to show. All animals attending Team Purebred The Coastal Battle must be inspected by a licensed and accredited veterinarian before departing for the show.

## <u>Health Papers/CVIs must be completed by a licensed and accredited veterinarian who has personally inspected the swine.</u> Each CVI must state the following:

- 1) All CVI's must be issued on May 1, 2024 and after, valid only for 30 days.
- 2) CVIs must clearly include a description of each animal including the age, sex, and breed of the animal, and the official individual identification, see options below for Individual ID
- 3) CVIs must have the consignee/destination address as: Team Purebred The Coastal Battle Tehama District Fairgrounds 650 Antelope Blvd. Red Bluff, CA 96080.
- 4) ALL CVIs MUST CARRY THE FOLLOWING STATEMENTS- "Farm or origin of swine"
  - a. The following statements for the farm or origin of swine:
  - b. Has not had pseudorabies or swine dysentery in the last 12 months
  - c. Has not had any clinical signs or diagnosis of TGE or PEDv in the last 60 days
  - d. Feeds no raw garbage and uses no PRV vaccine
  - e. Is not under quarantine for any disease condition
  - f. Has not had vesicular stomatitis diagnosed within 10 miles of farm or origin in the last 30 days
- 5) Premise identification number or State Location Identifier
- 6) Individual ID by official ID (USDA approved metal tag **OR** 840 RFID Tags)

## **Options:**

- A) A 15-digit RFID tag beginning with the numbers 840. These tags must be electronic in order to be official.
- B) An 8- or 9-digit metal tag. Often called Brite tags, pass tags, or Tuberculosis/Brucellosis test tags
- 7) **All Swine must have the following test performed:** Brucellosis and Pseudorabies testing (Must meet one of the following 2-options):

Originate from a Validated & Qualified (VQ) herd. The VQ number, most recent quarterly test date, and animal ID shall be listed on a valid Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI).

Negative Brucellosis and Pseudorabies tests within 30 days prior to the event. Test results, laboratory name, laboratory accession number, and animal ID shall be listed on a valid CVI.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to provide valid health papers at the show. Team Purebred cannot permit hogs to participate without valid health certificates. 8) <u>Vaccinations:</u> All breeding swine MUST be vaccinated against erysipelas and leptospirosis (6-way), including L. bratislava. b. It is highly recommended that all animals, including market animals, are vaccinated against swine influenza.

9) Out-of-state swine must have an entry permit. To obtain an Interstate Livestock Entry Permit, please contact Animal Health Branch (AHB) permit line at (916) 900-5052 before moving swine into the state. Permits are valid for 15 days after being issued. This must be done by your vet.

**NOTE:** The following animals are not eligible for exhibition in California:

- 1, Animals that originate from a herd that is under quarantine
- 2. An animal prohibited from exhibition under any law or order
- 3. Any animal classified as a brucellosis "suspect"
- 4. Animals showing signs of any infectious or communicable disease or that are a health hazard to people or other animals
- 5. Any animal that develops or shows signs of any infectious or communicable disease during exhibition must be removed from the premises, including the surrounding exhibition grounds. An owner who is disputing the exclusion of his/her animal(s) from exhibition may not exhibit the animal in question pending any appeal.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to provide valid health papers at the show. Team Purebred cannot permit hogs to participate without valid health certificates.
