Everyone needs to bring a copy of his or her health papers with each pig listed to the show. The Certificate of Veterinary Inspection must be issued within 30 days prior to exhibition.

The health papers **must have** the following information on them:

- 1) Premise identification number.
- 2) Individual ID by official ID (USDA approved metal tag or RFID tag).
 - A) A 15-digit RFID tag beginning with the numbers 840. These tags must be electronic to be official.
 - B) Please list your veterinarian's cell phone number on CVI if we have any questions.
 - C) ALL CVIs MUST CARRY THE FOLLOWING STATEMENTS- "Farm or origin of swine"
 - a. Has not had Pseudorabies or Swine Dysentery in the last 12 months
 - b. Has not had any clinical signs or diagnosis of TGE or PEDv in the last 60 days
 - c. Feeds no raw garbage and uses no PRV vaccine
 - d. Is not under quarantine for any disease condition

REQUIRED TEST: The Sweet Peach Regional is NOT considered 4-H and FFA shows, ALL animals **including GEORGIA** animals competing must meet the below mentioned blood test requirements on or after January 13th, 2025 unless you maintain a PRV qualified and Brucellosis validated herd.

3) Brucellosis and Pseudorabies testing (Must meet one of the following 2 options):

• Originate and be shown by the owner from a Validated & Qualified (VQ) herd. The VQ number, most recent quarterly test date, and animal ID shall be listed on a valid Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI).

<u>OR</u>

• Negative Brucellosis and Pseudorabies tests within 30 days prior to the event. Test Results, laboratory name, laboratory accession number, and animal ID shall be listed on a valid CVI.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to provide valid health papers at the show. Team Purebred cannot permit hogs to participate without valid health certificates. 4) All out-of-state exhibitions are required to have a permit. The individual families or management is responsible for obtaining the exhibition permit from the State Veterinarian at least twenty-one (21) days prior to the opening of the exhibition.
